COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS

LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

The driver must hold a minimum of a Motorsport New Zealand Clubsport Licence, have a current civil driver's license, and also be a financial member of an affiliated car club of NZ. All licenses are to be produced at Documentation.

DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING

PASSENGERS

Passengers are only allowed in cars with roll cages that have been scrutineered to take passengers. Passengers will be permitted on all runs so long as they have signed the indemnity form prior located at the caravan, this is the Drivers responsibility to check. Drivers are required to ensure all passengers wear safety equipment in accordance with Schedule A , which must also be available for inspection at scrutineering.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

Drivers briefing will be held at the venue at 8:30 am. This is compulsory for all competitors.

DAMAGE

Although MSNZ Public Liability Insurance will cover the event, all claims have an excess of \$3,500.00. Therefore competitors will be responsible for any damage they cause to public or private property and will be liable for the cost of repairs, up to the value of this excess.
